School in a One Room Schoolhouse

In one room school houses the little children sat in the front, while the older students sat in the back. The teacher taught reading, writing, arithmetic, history, and geography. All the students memorized and recited their lessons every day.

One-room schoolhouses were common, especially near farms or small towns where most families lived. The teacher would stand at the front where there would be a big blackboard. The students might have rows of desks or just benches to sit on.

In the One Room Schoolhouse the teacher was the principal, custodian, nurse, counselor and occasionally the cook. Some teachers had the help of older students to assist with these chores. Older students also would be asked to fetch a bucket of water from any nearby well. One room School houses were mostly painted red because it was the cheapest paint. In the 1840s the first one room Schoolhouse was created.
