WILDLIFE IN FRANKLIN

An animal in Franklin that is pretty common is the white-tailed deer. There are many white-tailed deer all around town. I have a family of them living in the woods by my house. Another common bird in Franklin is a blue jay. They are usually found in the eastern or central parts of the US. Blue jays are blue, medium-sized birds. These birds will make their nests in trees, bushes, and shrubs. Once, I saw a blue jay fly into my garage to build a nest with eggs!

If you were driving at night or looking outside, you've probably seen a red fox at one point. They are reddish-brown creatures with white stomachs and chests. They are typically found all over North America. They live in forests, woodlands, grasslands, mountains, and urban areas. They typically den in burrows, hollow logs, brush piles, or even under buildings or in urban green spaces. I've seen a red fox run across the woods in the snow. It was one of the most beautiful things I've ever seen!
